- Eligible to bowl in USBC certified tournaments through July 31
- Eligible to be nominated and apply for USBC scholarships including the Dexter/USBC High School All-American Team
- Ability to earn USBC Youth Honor Scores
- Ability to earn USBC High School awards
- One issue of *US Youth Bowler*
