# Inaugural Harvest 36 Singles Tournament Rules



## USBC rules are in effect for this tournament

- To enter this tournament you must be a member of USBC and **PRESENT YOUR CARD OR THIS YEAR'S TEMPORARY CARD WITH LAST YEAR'S MEMBERSHIP CARD AT CHECK-IN** or pay \$21 for an associate membership card. Those forgetting their card or losing their temporary membership card will be charged a \$5 reprint/verification fee that will be placed in the tournament prize fund.
- Contestants must use their highest USBC sanctioned average of 21 games or more for 2010-2011 season. Sport averages will be adjusted according to the USBC conversion chart. If an entrant doesn't have a previous season's average, they will enter with the scratch average of 225. Handicap will be 75% of 225.
- Prize fees will be returned 100%, in case of ties money will be split. Any Special Events prize money remaining will be added to the main prize fund for distribution. Any youth winning prize money will have their prize money deposited into a SMART account.
- Prizes will be paid within 2 hours of tournament completion unless held-up due to protest, appeal and or disqualification.
- If machinery breakdown occurs lasting more than 10 minutes, the tournament manager reserves the right to move bowlers to another pair of lanes. If bowlers are moved they will be given one ball practice on each lane prior to continuing the game.
- If a tournament frame or frames are irretrievably lost, the tournament manager has the right to request a re-bowl of lost frame(s) or refund entry fees.
- Bowlers will certify their scores as correct after each game by reviewing the game printout. Each bowler will sign the printout by their game as verification that they accept the printout.
- If a bowler doesn't strike in frame(s) 10, 22 and or 34; they are ineligible for the points of frames 12, 24, and 36. If the bowler spares in frame(s) 10, 22, and or 34; they are eligible for the events of frames 11, 23, and 35.
- If a bowler ends their game with a spare or strike, it will connect their next game. Please refer to the following examples:

- Special Event Frames
  - Jack-o-Lantern – bowlers must bowl strikes in the 2, 3 and 4<sup>th</sup> frames to qualify for the prize.
  - Scarecrow – bowlers must bowl strikes in the 16, 17, 18 and 19<sup>th</sup> (4-7<sup>th</sup> frames of game 2) frames to qualify for the prize.
  - Headless Horseman – bowlers must bowl strikes in the 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, and 36<sup>th</sup> (7-12<sup>th</sup> frames of game 3) frames to qualify for the prize.
- Position will be set based on adjusted game score plus your 3 game handicap.
- Entries will be returned, in full, if unforeseen circumstances cause cancellation of the tournament.

## Be a Group Coordinator

- Bring 10-19 other bowlers with you and receive half price Tournament entry, if they all participate in the Special Events receive half price Special Events entry.
- Bring 20 or more bowlers with you and receive free Tournament entry, if they all participate in the Special Events receive free Special Events entry.
