1. This is a non-sanctioned event. Adult non-sanctioned bowlers may participate. All Junior bowlers must be members of an established sanctioned Youth League

2. Junior bowlers are defined as those bowlers under 18 years of age.

3. Average / Handicap

a) Entrants will use current average based on a minimum of 21 games for the 2011 – 2012 winter season.

b) If no current average entrant will use highest average with a minimum of 21 games from the 2010 – 2011 winter season.

c) Failing to meet either of these criteria, entrant will bowl scratch.

d) Handicap will be 90% of 220.

4. Entry Fees per person, per event:

5. Prizes.

- a) Plaques will be awarded to 1st and 2nd place finishers in both team and doubles competition.
- b) No cash awards may be given to adult bowlers.
- c) Prize fund, in the ratio of 1:5 per event, will be distributed in the form of Smart Scholarships to Junior Bowlers.

RULES for DOUBLES

1. Team must be comprised of one junior and one adult.
2. **FOR RE-ENTRY ONLY**
 - Re-entries will be allowed with a different partner.
 - Entry fee per bowler will be reduced to \$18 if the partners are from different associations.
3. No limit but restricted to space availability.

RULES for TEAMS

1. Team must consist of 2 juniors and two adults.
2. **FOR RE-ENTRY ONLY**
 - Re-entries will be allowed, but entrants may not bowl with more than one team member from a previous team.
 - Entry fee will be reduced by \$1 per bowler for each different association represented on the team.
3. No limit but restricted to space availability.
